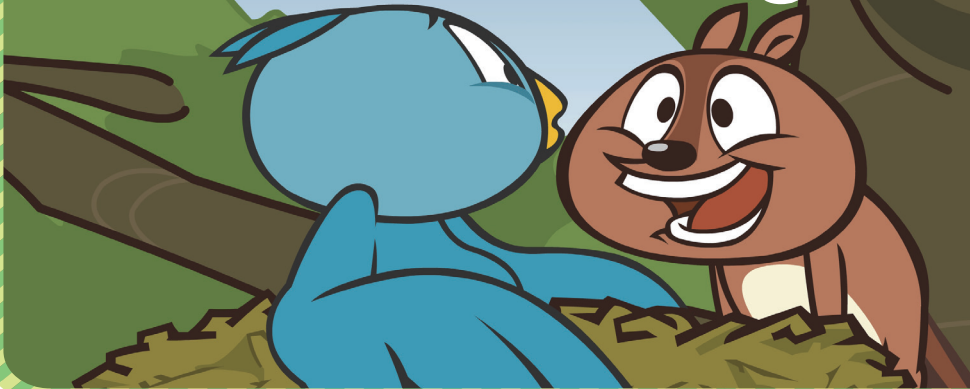

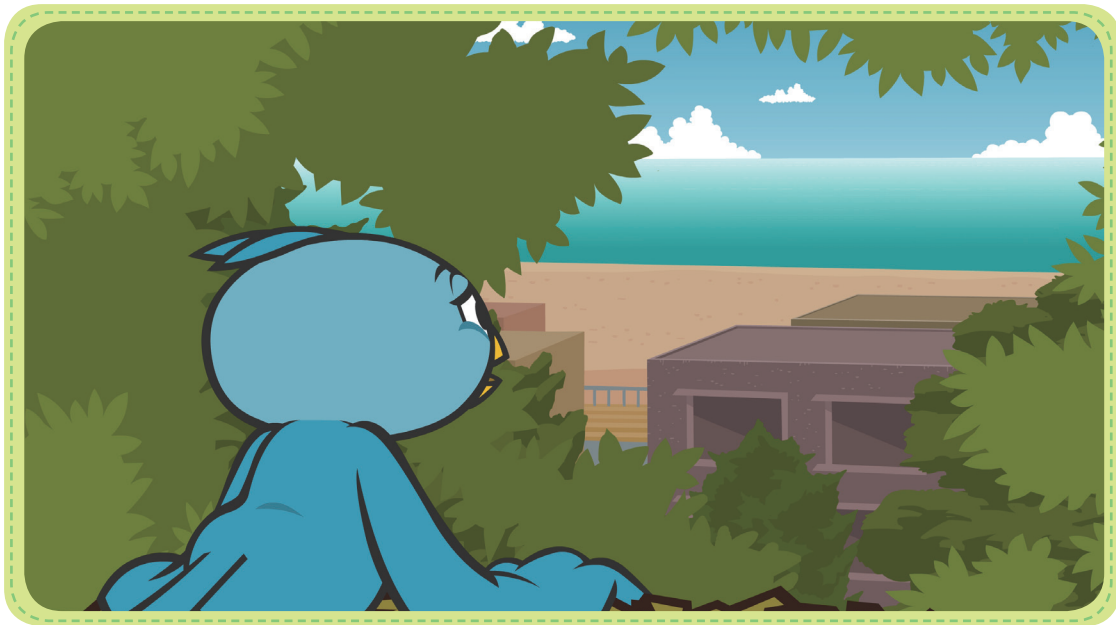
Bird and Kip 2

Bird's New Neighbor

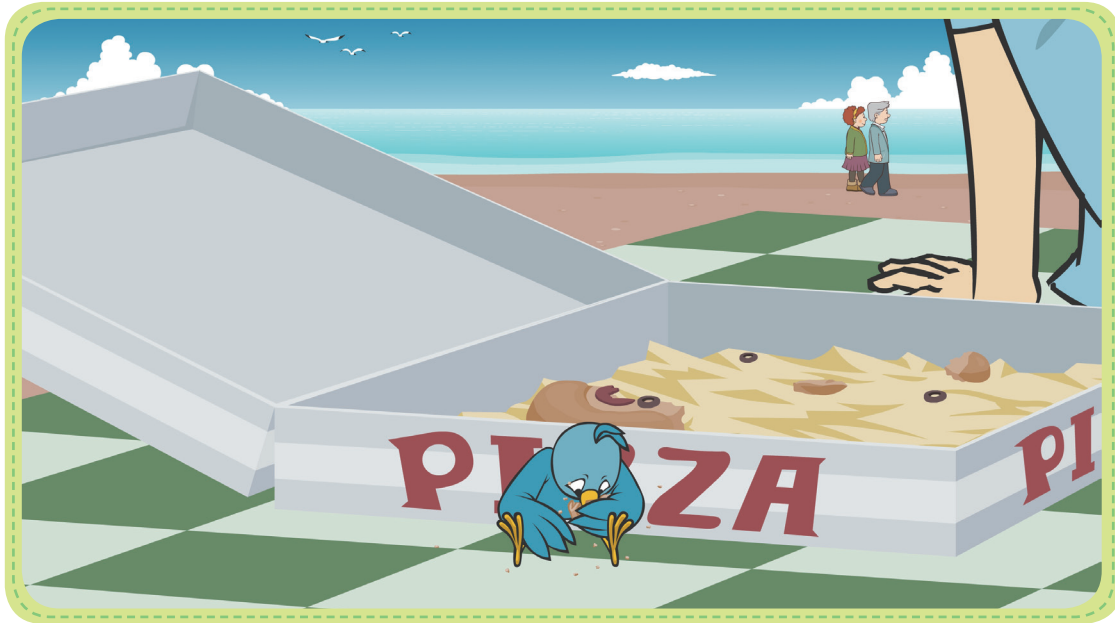




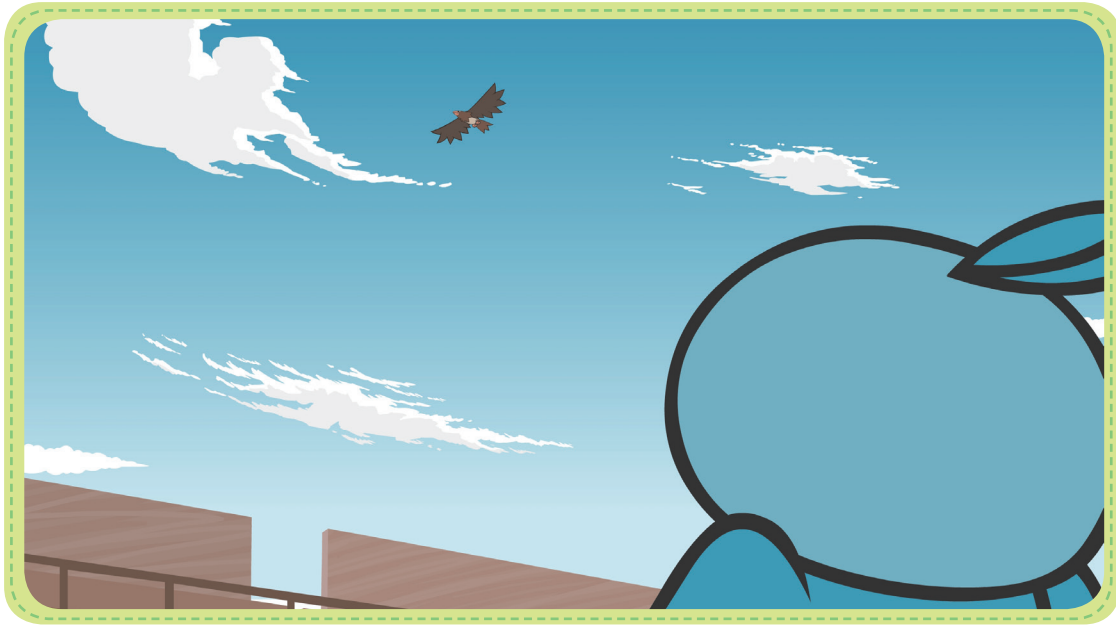
Bird did not like having a neighbor.

“I love the beach,” she said.



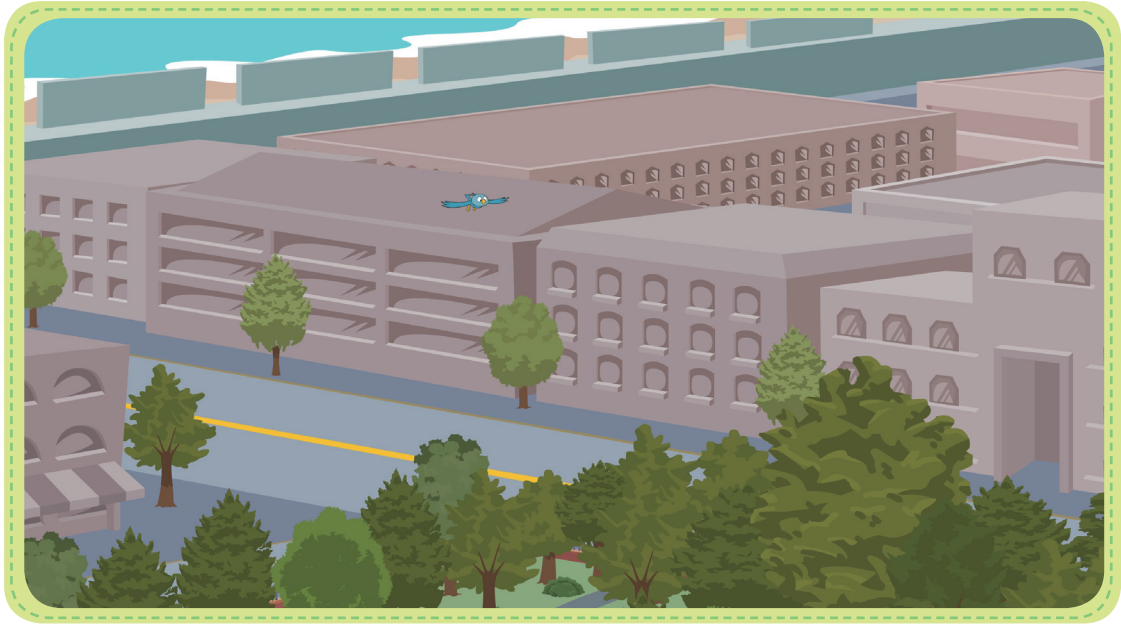
Just then Bird saw something.
